Subject: Labeling Updates for Mobile Home Condensers

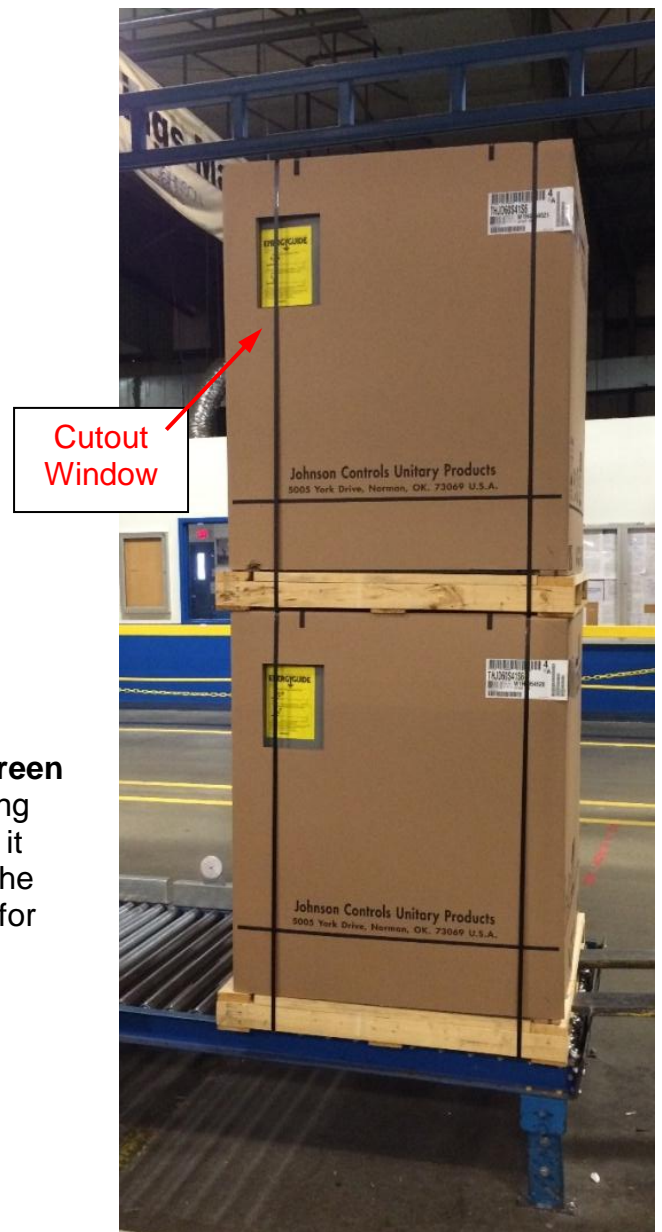
Changes to the labeling of Mobile Home condenser are being implemented in time for January 1, 2015. The first change affects the visibility of the FTC EnergyGuide label. The second change is to the carton label for quick identification of 2015-built product.

Visibility of the FTC EnergyGuide Label

New FTC regulations go into effect January 1, 2015 that require the yellow FTC "Hang Tag" to be visible from the outside of a unit while the unit is still packaged. The residential furnaces, air handlers, and packaged units already meet this requirement due to the clear plastic packaging. For the residential AC and HP outdoor units, a cutout window is being added to the cardboard box packaging so that the EnergyGuide label already on the unit is visible from the outside. This change will be implemented through the month of December, and will be fully in place for all products manufactured January 1, 2015 and later.


Carton Label Background Color Changing to Light Green

The unit's date of manufacture is a factor in determining compliance with the 2015 Regional Standards. To make it easier to determine that a unit is built on or after 1/1/15, the color of the carton label stock is being changed to green for Mobile Home condensers built in 2015:
